Chardonnay, Viognier, Roussanne, Marsanne



Château Haut-Blanville is a family wine estate located in Saint-Pargoire, near Montpellier in Hérault (34). Created in 1997 by Bernard and Béatrice Nivollet, they are currently handing over to their daughters and the Blanville team. Specializing in the production of single-parcel wines, each cuvée comes from a plot that has been carefully selected over the years. Château Haut-Blanville offers ready-to-drink wines with high aging potential, with long aging in barrels.



Terroir: Charmes, clay and limestone with small pebbles, 200m of altitude.

«Floral, heady, blousy, key lime, oak spice. Oak-striped fruit does the helter-skelter down a spiral twist-twirl of lollipop green and apple sherbet and peppermint candy and crushed grass where we picnicked picking daisies and sucking on their stems. And there is the little bitter swipe of hops from the lager-light kiss of someone drinking golden beer and a hint of flowers from the lips of the prosecco-sipper leaning against your back and then you lift your palm off the wet grass and it smells of clay.»
